Eligibility:

- You must be a British citizen
- You must be 18 years or older

and at least one of the following apply:

- You are an elector for the Parish; or
- You have resided or rented/tenanted land in the Parish for the past 12 months; or
- You have had your principal or only place of work in the Parish for the past 12 months; or
- You have lived within 3 miles of the Parish for the past 12 months
